Travel Award Applications

The SCMR is delighted to announce the SCMR 2019 Travel Awards for the 22nd Annual Scientific Sessions.

The purpose of the travel award is to encourage and facilitate a wider attendance to the meeting by all students/trainees, or younger professionals (< 10 years from MD, or <5 years from PhD degree award), or established professionals with special circumstances (see application) from all countries.

Eligibility:

- Be a SCMR member for 2019 at the time of application.
- Be the presenting author of at least one (1) accepted abstract, case, or poster.
- Be an author of at least one (1) accepted abstract, case, poster (only applicable for the Technologist Scholarship).
- Previous travel award winners are not eligible.
- Applicants who list gender and ethnicity may be eligible for additional funding.

Application:

- Briefly state your interest and involvement in CMR, including service to the SCMR or a local affiliate.
- Describe any circumstances that influence your need for this travel award.
- One (1) letter of recommendation that addresses the following points from a mentor (1-page limit) on official institutional letterhead:
 - An assessment of the applicant's specific ability and accomplishments.
 - An assessment of the applicant's potential to contribute to the research, education, and/or clinical missions of the SCMR.
 - Any circumstances influencing the need for this travel award.
 - Acceptable File Types: .DOC, .DOCX, .PDF
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
 - Acceptable File Types: .DOC, .DOCX, .PDF

Funding and Award Process:

- The travel awards consist of complimentary registration to the SCMR 22nd Annual Scientific Sessions and a financial stipend to cover travel expenses.
- The travel awards are designed to cover/contribute to costs exclusively related to travel and accommodation associated with attendance at this important meeting.
- The recipients of the travel awards will be selected by a committee composed of SCMR representatives.
- Please note that number and amount of awards will vary from region to region, depending on the number and quality of applications, motivation of the applicant, and the estimated cost of travel from the region to the meeting.

Submission:

- The SCMR Submission Site will close on **Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at 12:00 PM (noon) Eastern Daylight Time (EDT)**.
